

1-Cisco Call Manager

You may logon to the Cisco Call Manager using any of the following certified browsers: Internet Explorer 6.0 or 7.0, Mozilla Firefox 2.0.0.5, or Apple Safari.

These images in this document are from Internet Explorer 6.0 You may see different windows and screens if you use other web browsers such as Mozilla Firefox, Apple Safari, Netscape, Konquer, Opera and others.



@ the User Options Menu

A user may have more than 1 phone number associated with multiple devices e.g.

- Cisco IP Communicator
- Cisco 7910
- Cisco 7960
- Cisco 7970
- ...newer IP Phone models... Make sure you select the proper device. If you are not sure, just look at the back of your phone, there should be a Mac Address e.g. 000368890E4C, then compare to what you see on the User Options Menu (Device profile SEP**000368890E4C**, you can see

Click the Options you want to change e.g.

- Add/Update Speed Dials
- **IP Phone Services**

the Mac Address match.

You can change your Password and match for e.g. your CESNetID password.

Add/Update Speed Dials

Type the phone number or extension under 'Speed Dial' 1, 2, 3, etc and type a Name under 'Display Text'.

Depends of your phone model, you can add multiple Speed Dial numbers. Make sure there's no dashes e.g. 91234567

Add campus extensions -

Just put the 4 digits extensions (this is for the old 293-3111 numbers), for the new prefix, please type the 5 digits extensions: e.g. 53211 (new prefix numbers is for e.g. 675-3211)

Off-campus (local calls) To dial off-campus, make sure you put 9 + phone numbers (no dashes)

Speed dial not associated w/ a phone button

Any numbers and display text you typed won't be shown on your phone. But you can still use it (from your IP Phone) press e.g. 5 and press the button 'AbbrDial'. You can see the entire phone number on your display. You just need to remember what numbers you assigned for each speed dial.

Long Distance

It's recommended not to put your authorization code number on Speed Dial. That way there won't be any abuse.

Do not put your authorization code in Speed dial. Other users may take advantage of your code and dial long distance calls without your knowledge.

After you typed the numbers and Name, don't forget to scroll all the way down and click **Update**, elick **Return to the Menu** and **Log Off** from the web site.



Your phone will then be updated. Please test it, to make sure everything is working OK.



3-Change Background Images

You can change the Wallpaper if you have a Color IP Phones, just click the Settings button, click Background Images and click Select.

For those with black & white IP phone, there's no wallpaper background.



Please use the **Navigation** button in order to make the right selection.



Choose the image you want and click **Select**. Don't forget to **Save** it and click **Exit**. You should now see new Wallpaper.

4-Change Rings

From your IP Phone (model 7970), click the **Settings** button/**User Preferences/Rings**

You can **play** a ring that you want and then **save** it. Next time someone calls your extension, you will hear the new ring tone. Just click **Exit** when you are done.

For the model 7961-G (black & white sets): click the **Settings** button/**User Preferences/Rings**, click **Select**, you can try any rings you want (just click Play), don't forget to click Select, you will see a check mark, then click Save. Just click Exit when you are done.
